Please check your communication trays (on top of the water bottle shelf) and read our <u>front</u> whiteboard each day to stay up to date with events and important messages.





# PRESCHOOL SESSION TIMES

Our door will open at 8:45am each morning. Prior to this our educators are busy setting up for the day and sharing important information. We ask that if you arrive before this time you support your child to apply suncream and be mindful to socially distance from other families where possible. Please remember to sign your child in each day and record if there will be someone different (i.e. grandparents, OSHC) collecting your child.

8:45am to 2:45pm



At approximately 9am children will gather for our morning 'Wondering Time'. This may be a good opportunity for you to say farewell to your child if you are both feeling happy and comfortable by then. Our educators are always available to support you and your child as you say goodbye.

In the afternoon children will gather all together for a story or song at approximately 2:30pm. If you arrive early please be respectful as this is still an important learning moment in your child's day at preschool. You are welcome to quietly join us on the mat to listen and engage with our end of day group.

You may notice some children will have packed their own bags and other children are still learning to do this independently. It is a good idea to check before leaving your child has all their belongings (water bottle, food containers, clothing and hat).



Between 2:30pm & 2:45pm we will individually farewell each child, once we can see their special person who is picking them up. You need to ensure you have arrived to collect your child by no later than 2:45pm each day. We understand occasionally things come up which may cause you to be running late as a once off. If this happens please give us a call or a text so we can reassure your child you are on your way to collect them.

If there is a reason you need to leave earlier on a certain occasion please let an educator know so we can say goodbye to your child as you arrive.

We know your child will be so excited to see you at the end of the day, if they do run to greet you before being farewelled from the group, please support them to come back to the mat with them while we goodbye. This will support your child to understand our end of day routine whilst also allowing them to be with you!

Part of our intentional teaching with the children each day incorporates learning about our feelings and emotions. This forms part of our <u>'Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum'</u> which is integrated into our preschool curriculum.

Our educators support children to recognise how their body is feeling and how they express and learn to manage their emotions in different situations. Children are increasing their vocabulary to name their emotions such as sad, angry, frustrated, joyful or tired. Children are learning that all emotions are okay and sometimes we just need a little support to manage them.

#### You may notice our educators:

- Naming and acknowledging children's emotions.
- Using a quiet and calm voice.
- Getting down to children's level.
- Offering physical reassurance.
- Respecting and allowing the need for personal space by staying nearby.


What strategies have you noticed that help you support your child with their emotions?

We will continue to share further information about our Child Protection Curriculum throughout the year with you.

At our preschool we refer to children's drawing and writing as 'mark making'. We value and provide opportunities for children to authentically engage with this in a variety of ways throughout each day.

#### This may look like children:

- Using a stick to make marks in the sand.
- Exploring with mixing and creating varying shades of paints to use within their artwork.
- Using their three, four and five year old writing to name their artworks.
- Being authors and illustrators of their own books.
- Writing a menu in our mud kitchen.







Independence and self help skills are vital components of children's development.

You can support your child develop these by encouraging them to:

- Dress themselves (including socks and shoes).
- Make choices that affect them: e.g. "Do you want a banana or grapes today?"
- Involve them with packing their own bag at home with everything they need for kindy (hat, change of clothes, water bottle, morning food & lunch). On arrival at kindy children can be supported to unpack their bag and put it in a locker. While children are still becoming familiar with our routine they may need some verbal prompts, however please let them try and do it by themselves. This also supports children to recognise and find their own belongings throughout the day.
- Think about how to solve a problem themselves,
   "What could you do to fix it?"

If you write it for me, cut it for me, or open it for me... then your brain is learning, not mine.

## LAUNDRY LEGENDS

Please discourage your children from climbing and swinging on this rail as they enter and leave preschool each day.

## Sign in sheet: Notes column If someone other than

yourself is picking up your child (grandparent, childcare, friend etc.) please write this in the 'notes' column in the morning. They will also need to be listed on your child's enrolment form. Please let them know our educators may ask for photo ID if we haven't met them before. This is a precaution to ensure your child's safety.

A reminder to also check the 'notes' column at the end of the day as sometimes this will say 'see staff' if we need to speak with you.
